Founded in 1933, the IRC offers lifesaving care and life-changing assistance to refugees forced to flee from war or disaster.

Regional Research & Monitoring Officer

The candidate is expected to perform the following duties:

- to design surveys, including sampling and data collection instruments such as questionnaires
- to analyze, interpret and present in a user-friendly manner monitoring, assessment and research data
- to coordinate with the IRC country programmes (currently Turkey, Jordan, Iraq) to ensure a consistent and harmonized regional approach

The key functions of this post require someone who is technically strong in research, client service oriented, able to work remotely with colleagues and flexible in responding to changing work contexts.
